CACHES IN THE GARDENS HAVE CLUES ABOUT LOCAL AUTHORS

FLAGSTAFF, March 31, 2011. The Arboretum at Flagstaff presents *Author's Trail: Geocaching at The Arboretum* on April 15, 2011 from 2:00 – 5:00 pm. This event is put on in partnership between The Arboretum at Flagstaff and The Northern Arizona Book Festival and features local children's authors Linda Kranz, Lori Rome, Seth Muller, and Matthew Henry Hall. The geocaching event invites kids to find caches with clues about the authors along the nature trail. Participants will have the chance to use GPS devices to collect the clues, and then meet with the authors to learn more about their books. Bookman's of Flagstaff will provide a craft station where kids can decorate their own book totes. This event is free. Children of all ages are welcome.

The Arboretum is a botanical garden, research center, and nature preserve dedicated to educating the public about the plants and plant communities of the Colorado Plateau. It is located four miles south of Route 66 on scenic Woody Mountain Road in west Flagstaff. The Arboretum is open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., April through October.
